## Helping your child at home

Reading in Year 2 - Please continue to read frequently with your child at home (at least three times each week, more if you are able to). Reading is such a huge part of your child's learning journey and is the basis of everything we do. Your child will be bringing home a book of their choice, along with a correctly levelled book




bag book and a RWI book that has recently been read in class. Please listen to your child read these books, asking them questions about what they have read. This will really help with your child's comprehension skills. Once your child has read 10 times at home they will be presented with a special reading sticker.

Homework Tasks - This year we will no longer be setting homework on Seesaw. We will however be setting work to complete each week on TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed. We would also like children to read frequently (see details above) and practice reading and writing the words that are stuck in to the back of your child's reading diary. Please work on these each week throughout the year and mark off when your child can read and write the words correctly. We have included Year I and Year 2 words so that you are able to start at a point that is appropriate for your child.

### Maths

- Help your child to learn their times tables x2, x5 x10
- Help your child to tell the time confidently begin with o'clock,
   half past, quarter to and quarter past. Move on to 5 minute
   intervals if your child is confident.



- Addition and subtraction work
- Fractions of shapes 1/2, 1/4

Any extra support you give your child with their maths work will really help them to be more confident in class. Thank you for all you continue to do.



<u>PE</u> - We would like all children to continue to come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days (Mondays and Wednesdays). Please wear full PE kit on these days. Please remove earrings at home on PE days so that they don't have to be taken out in school.

<u>Snack</u> - All Year 2 children will continue to be given a piece of fruit at morning break time. If your child would prefer to bring their own snack it must be piece of fruit.
